BY CAR:

The venue is accessible from highway A73, at south of Nijmegen.
You can take exit 2: Nijmegen-Dukenburg.
At the first traffic light you take a right turn.
After approx. 2 km. on the right hand side you will see a sand path and
a sign for Het Buitencentrum, this is the entrance to the venue.

BY PUBLIC TRANSPORT:

- From Amsterdam Schiphol Airport -

By train from Schiphol Airport to Nijmegen Central Station.

- From Rotterdam Airport -

Shuttle bus 33 to Rotterdam Central Station.
Train from Rotterdam Central Station to Nijmegen Central Station.

- From Eindhoven Airport -

Airport bus 401 to Eindhoven central station.
Train from Eindhoven Central Station to Nijmegen Central Station.

- From Dusseldorf Weeze -

Airport Bus to Nijmegen central station.

- From Nijmegen Central Station to Venue -

Take the bus for line 9 from the central station to the bus stop directly by the venue.
(Buses run twice an hour and the journey is approximately 25 minutes)
Alternatively take a taxi from outside the central station directly to Het Buitencentrum

- The Venue -

The Zappateers have booked a great indoor venue in a lovely forest location a few kilometres outside the historic Dutch city of Nijmegen.

- Festival Timings -

The festival site is open from 16:00 CET on Friday 14th March to 14:00 Sunday 16th March. The festivities will start at 18:00 CET on the Friday and will proceed till late on the Saturday night, by which time you will have been entertained by 6 bands playing the music of Uncle Frank.

- Accommodation -

The accommodation is best thought of as indoor camping with basic dormitory style rooms for 4 to 12 people with separate shower and toilet rooms. You will need to bring your own pillow case, sheet and sleeping bag.

- Food and Drink -

Food and more importantly drink will be available at the venue.

- Tickets -

Tickets are priced at 80 Euro to include accommodation for 2 nights and for all the fun of the fair. Payment can be made either by direct bank transfer (IBAN/SWIFT) or PayPal (incurs a 5% charge to cover the PayPal fees).
